Under what migrant schemes did people arrive?

Immigrants travelled under different schemes. **Assisted passengers** received a government subsidy and paid a small charge or were free. **Remittance or Nominated** passages were arranged by a friend or relative living in Australia, who paid a warrant for their passage to the Government. **Indentured immigrants** were brought out as contract labourers for employers who paid the Government for their passage. **Unassisted**

immigrants paid full fare. More information exists for assisted passengers but the amount varies according to time period and the colony or State. Check guides for each State for further information.

What resources are available?

The following **indexes** and **lists** are a **selection** that will help you trace your ancestor's arrival in Australia.

Other Passenger and Shipping Lists

Queensland State Archives website also holds other indexes that relate to immigration lists such as Immigrant Agent's lists. These can be found on the **Immigration** page <https://www.qld.gov.au/recreation/arts/heritage/archives/immigration/>

National Archives Australia Record Search <http://www.naa.gov.au/collection/recordsearch/index.aspx> provides access to 20th Century indexes and lists for all Australian states. For 1898-1966 check *Passenger Arrivals Index* tab in Search screen. Also available are Brisbane incoming lists, 1852-1964, Series no. J715, Rolls 1-42 (Use advanced item search and know the date range).

Emigrants from Hamburg to Australia

This index (FAMHIS 929.3943 1991; QCFS 929.3943 2006), compiled by Eric and Rosemary Kopittke, lists German and some Scandinavian immigrants for the years 1850-1879 at the point of departure. There are indexes for 1850-1859 and 1860-69 together with the lists on open access. For the 1870s use the index at the back of each book. These records are also available on CD-ROM (QCFS 929.3943 2006) at the Family History reference desk on Level 3.

The **Shipping Intelligence** column of Australian newspapers reported daily arrivals and departures for overseas and coastal shipping. Usually, names of full fare paying passengers are listed, plus the name of the Captain, details of the ship's cargo and sometimes a report of the voyage; and the condition and character of the immigrants.

Early shipping in Moreton Bay: June 1846-December 1859 and **Early shipping in Moreton Bay : January 1860-December 1863** (both at FAMHIS 387.2.1998) contain newspaper passenger lists of unassisted migrants and shipping news from information extracted from the *Moreton Bay Courier's* shipping reports. Names are indexed at the back.

Passenger lists from the Melbourne newspaper **Argus** 1846-1868 (MFC 929.3945 1993) are indexed.

The Hodge Index (MFC 929.39423 1990) is an index to passenger lists published in South Australian newspapers for S.A. ports and New Zealand, 1837-1855.

Sources for SA shipping records 1836 to 1842 [CD-ROM] (QCFS 929.39423 2006) compiled by Graham Jaunay, is a database that provides vessel name and voyage details, the sources, and a listing of passengers.

Register of New Zealand immigrants of Scottish birth arriving before 1 January 1921 (MFC 929.393 1999-2005), is compiled by Scottish Interest Group of the New Zealand Society of Genealogists, and can be searched via surname, place of birth, year of birth or year of arrival.

They came to New Zealand from Staffordshire, Warwickshire and Worcestershire [CD-ROM] (QCFS 929.393 2009), by Derek Griffis, contains names of immigrants to New Zealand from Staffordshire, Warwickshire and Worcestershire and lists, where known, name of immigrant, date and place of birth, date of death, date of arrival in New Zealand, name of ship, occupation, family relationships, married women's maiden name, and date of citizenship.

Also available through **ancestry.com** (Library edition), *onsite* only, are passenger lists to the USA and Canada as well as *UK Incoming Passenger Lists, 1878-1960* and *UK Outward Passenger Lists 1890-1960*.

Check **findmypast.com.au**, available *onsite* only, for *Passengers leaving the UK 1890-1960*.

Check the State Library One Search online catalogue or *Info Guide 3.11 – Immigration & shipping: more than lists*.
