AGCI : Australasian genealogical computer index

Previously only available on microfiche, this is a surname index to 3.9 million mainly Australian and New Zealand records of the 19th and 20th centuries. The index draws on records from cemetery transcriptions, parish registers, newspapers, rate books, war memorials, and shipping records. However, indexes to the New South Wales Government Gazette 1832-1850 that were included in the microfiche edition are not on the CD. Entries provide surname, given name, place and date of event, type of record, name of the organization submitting the record and location within that organization.

AGCI Volume 2 : Australasian genealogical computer index volume 2: NSW government gazettes 1832-1863

Volume 2 of AGCI contains an index to over 830,000 names mentioned in a variety of notice published in the New South Wales Government Gazette between 1832 and 1863. These notices include convicts, ship and military deserters, land transactions, unclaimed letters, government appointments and bankruptcies. The State Library of Queensland holds the New South Wales on microfilm and/or the original books.

Ludwig Bruck was a medical practitioner and medical journalist as well as the compiler of the first five editions of the Australasian Medical Directory and Hand Book between 1883 and 1900. The Australasian Medical Directory and Hand Book, contains a large amount of statistics and current medical information for all of the Australian states, New Zealand, and several of the Pacific islands including Fiji, Samoa and New Caledonia.

It is a comprehensive and authoritative source of information regarding the Catholic Church for the period in Australia, New Zealand and Oceania. This CD-ROM is searchable as the page images were scanned and converted into text within an Adobe Reader file to create a searchable, scrollable image.

Often given are the latitude and longitude, populations, local industries, hotels and many more. They do vary a little between states, but primarily each contains information on services within the state, such as military, medical, banking, pastoral, government, educational, ecclesiastical, railways, post and telegraph, geographical, lands department and so much more. They also contain thousands of photographs (mostly of people), together with thousands of biographies.

This CD-ROM is a digital reproduction of the original book. 'Australian Men of Mark' was produced in two large volumes in 1888/1889. It is a wonderful centennial biographical record of thousands of men of the time. This digital edition is unique and valuable in that it gathers all seven known variants of volume 2 into one complete fully searchable publication. All of volume 1 and much of volume 2 contain substantial biographies and full page illustrations of the person concerned. Most volume 2 volumes also include a significant selection of mini-biographies - enabling inclusion of many more than would have been possible in larger form. There are nearly 750 main biographies and over 3000 mini-biographies in the appendixes of some of the volume 2 series.

Emigrants from Hamburg to Australia 1850-1879

This CD-ROM is a consolidation of the full 21 publications previously released, into one index and a set of linked PDF files. It covers all available departure lists for ships from Hamburg to Australia and New Zealand during the period of 1850-1879, and information such as name, former place of residence, age, occupation, ship, destination and departure years are recorded for more than 40,000 emigrants. The index allows direct searching, using QFHSdatasearch, on name, year and other details, with search results directly linked to the relevant PDF file of the original publications. Not only does it cover all the information from the original Hamburg listings, much of which is unavailable on corresponding arrival lists, but also includes, in the PDF files, information on the ship and reports extracted from contemporary newspapers.
