

Prize terms and conditions

- Entry is open to Queensland residents only. Staff and volunteers of the Library Board of Queensland, the State Library of Queensland, participating public libraries or their partners and children will not be eligible to enter.
- Entry into the **major prize draw** is open to participants who have completed one or more modules and completed the pre and post course survey by the required date.
- Entry into the **monthly prize draw** is open to participants who have completed one or more modules.
- Completion of a module means that some or all activities and the final quiz have been undertaken and completed.
- The judges' decision in relation to any aspect of the competition is final and binding on each person who enters. No correspondence will be entered into.
