Cows taller than giraffes and one-eyed creatures that shoot laser beams are some of the wacky cardboard creations on display in State Library of Queensland's latest exhibition opening 11 December.

The Great and Grand Rumpus invites visitors to run wild among five-metre-high cardboard sculptures brought to life by interactive digital projections.

Over 1,000 innovative storytellers crafted and sculpted mythical worlds and creatures based on ideas workshopped by school children over the past 15 months.

Visitors can help build on this work by crafting their own mythical creations; from koi lanterns to board games and more. In the land of imagined things anything is possible at State Library.
