Next week Neoflex flooring will be replaced on the level 4 corridor near Fiona Foley's Black Opium installation. And from Monday 6 April, the hot water system located in the car park will be upgraded. It will take ten days to install and commission the system. Staff working onsite next week may experience disruption to hot water in the change rooms and kitchen sinks between 9am and 5pm. Facilities will advise of further maintenance work as it is scheduled.
