Returning to the office

Stage 3 Easing of Restrictions commenced at noon in Queensland today. The Chief Health Officer (CHO) has advised that “you can return to your workplace, including office workers”. The next phase will see government agencies enact a transition to return 50% of remote workers. The transition needs to be undertaken in a safe and measured way to ensure the safety of staff. Over the next week, we will be consulting with People Leaders on how we manage the transition back to State Library. It is anticipated that the transition will take several weeks. The CHO advice on “*physical distancing and hygiene; stay at home if you are sick; frequent cleaning and disinfection etc*” currently continue to apply.

Further details will be provided to you as we confirm logistics and other arrangements to allow a safe return to work for us all in the coming weeks.

John Oxley Library reopening
