B *Dolly Birds on a Wire* Laurie Nilsen

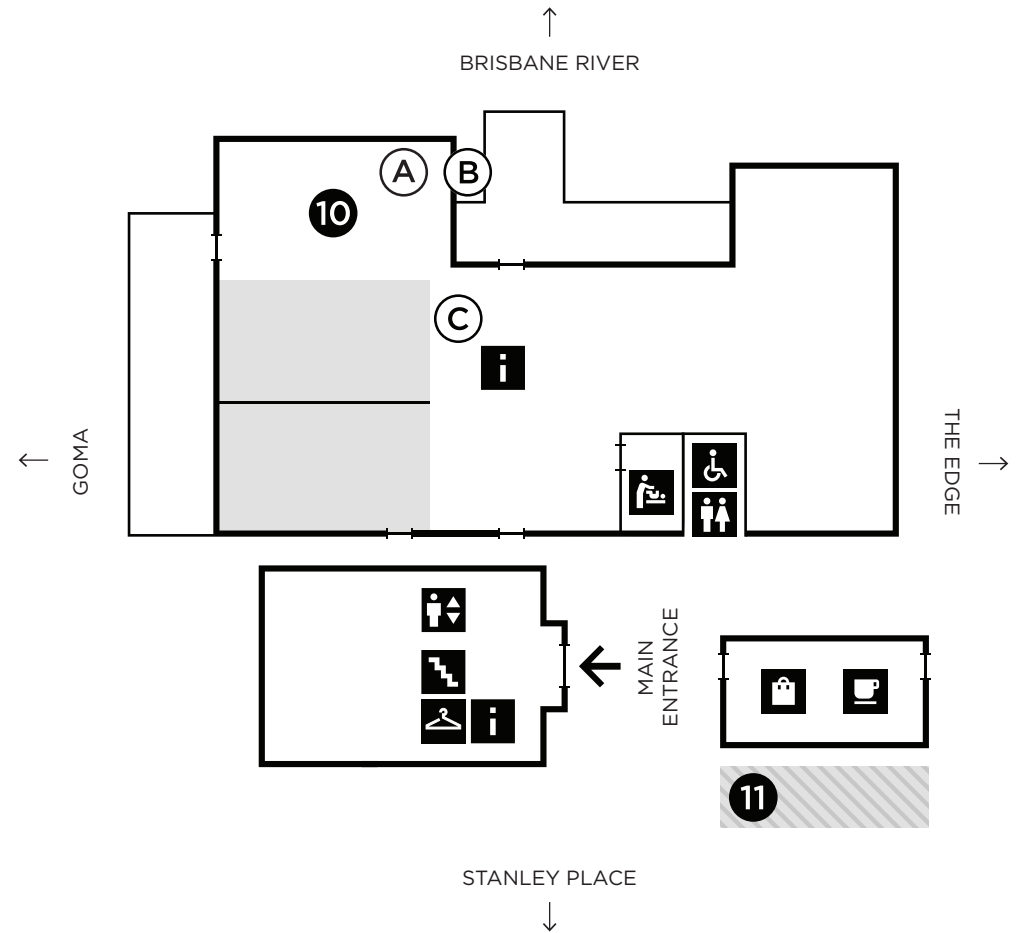
Made from steel and wire, this sculpture depicts the thousands of native animals that die every year on barbed-wire fences.
