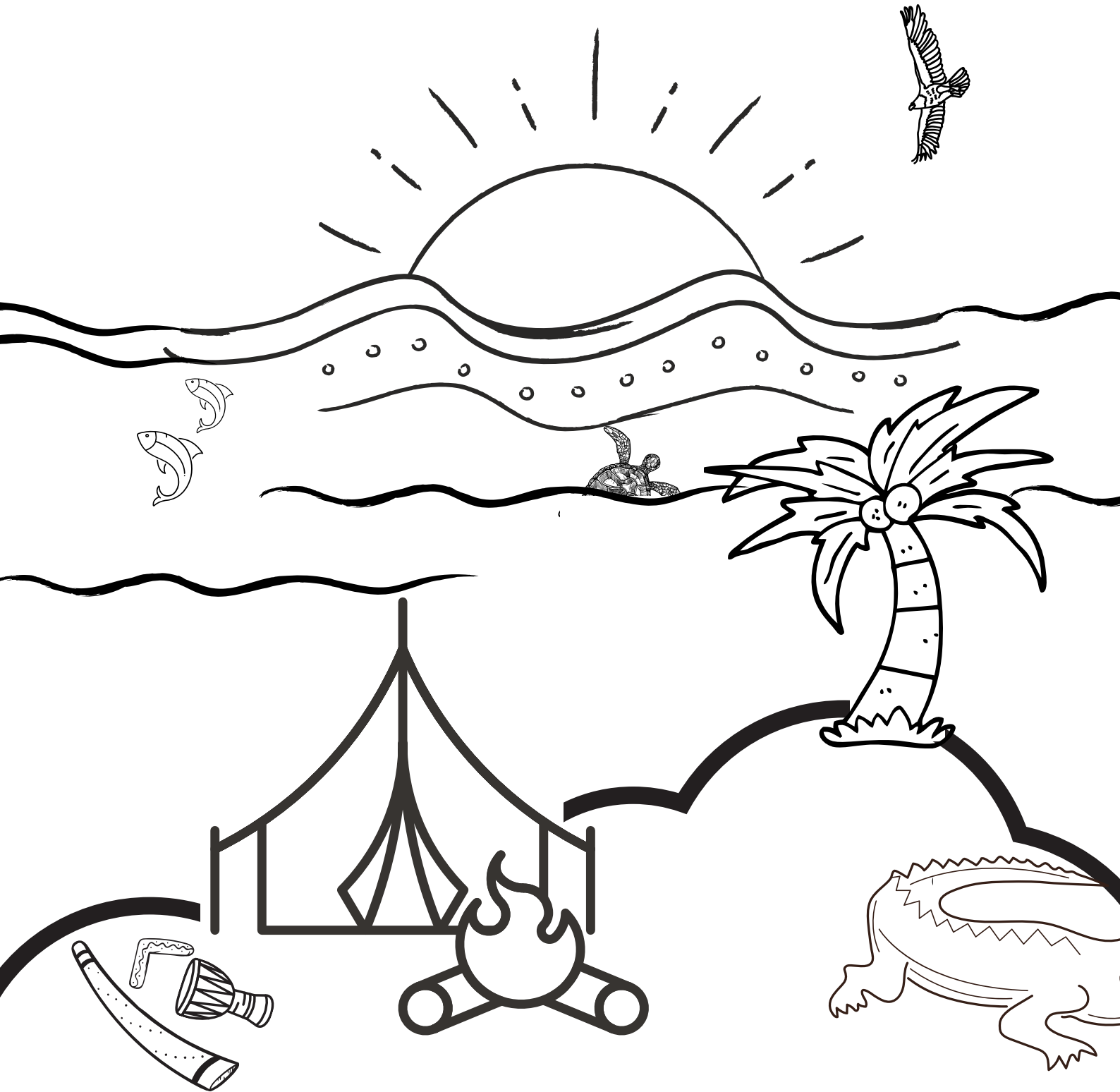


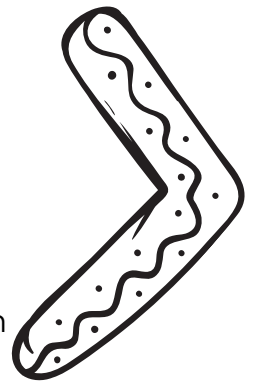
CULTURE QUEST
